Rules of Use

HOURS OF OPERATION FOR RESIDENTS' USE (Businesses MUST use a commercial hauler)

BULK, TRASH, AND RECYCLING DROP-OFF:

Sat: 7 am - 2 pm

HAZARDOUS WASTE/E-WASTE/ DOCUMENT SHREDDING:

RFK Stadium Lot 3, 2400 E Capitol St NE
One Thursday (10 am-2 pm) & one Saturday
(7 am-2 pm) each month.

- Drop-off services are available only to District residents. District residents must provide a valid DC driver's license, REAL ID non-driver identification card, or two documents that verify residency, such as a real property tax or utility bill.
- Acceptable materials include yard waste, trash, recyclables, and bulk items only. View the full list of accepted materials at dpw.dc.gov.
- Waste materials must come from within the District of Columbia. Facility staff has the authority to request proof of origin.
- Before entering the station, all drivers must have a valid driver's license. Additionally, vehicles entering the transfer station must be registered with the appropriate authority and have insurance.
- Access is permitted for the following vehicles:
 - Passenger cars
 - Passenger vans
 - SUVs
 - Pick-up trucks and vans less than 14 feet in length.
NOTE: Rental vehicles within these categories are accepted.
- Vehicles that have sideboards, ladder racks, stake bodies, cargo vans, trucks longer than 14 feet, tag-along trailers, commercial license tags, or belong to businesses/commercial entities. **WILL NOT BE GRANTED ACCESS.**
- Commercial haulers wishing to use the facility must call (202) 576-7659 to establish an account.
- All drop-off users must observe posted rules and safety and unloading instructions provided by facility staff.
- All drop-off users are expected to clean all spillage caused by off-loading their waste materials.
- Smoking, drinking, foul language, and gambling are prohibited.
- Children under the age of 13 and all pets must always remain in the vehicle.
- Persons with disabilities and senior citizens are asked to contact our office at (202) 715-7570 to make advance arrangements for assistance in removing items from their vehicles.
