- Lighter fluid,
- Mercury thermometers,
- Moth balls, Motor oil,
- Paint,
- Pesticides and poisons,
- Roofing tar,
- Solvents/thinners,
- Transmission, Windshield wiper and
- Brake fluids,
- Wood preservatives

### Electronics Recycling

#### Acceptable Items

- TVs (19" or less)
  - Monitors,
  - Memory chips,
  - Tape drives,
  - Floppy drives,
  - Pagers,
  - Connectors / Cords / Wire,
  - Fax machines,
  - Modems,
  - Audio/visual equipment,
  - CD Rom drives,
  - VCR's,
  - Motherboards, Printers,
  - Scrap computer plastic,
  - Camcorders,
  - Hard drives,
  - Network / Video / Sound cards,
  - Cell Phones,
  - Power supplies
  - Scrap computer metal,
  - Copy machines
