BLUE Cart Recycling

- All recyclables can be placed together in a single container.
- You can recycle more materials in your **BLUE** cart.
- Wheels and a grab-bar make moving the cart easier.
- The hinged lid keeps materials inside the cart, not blowing down the street.
- Cardboard and paper do not have to be bundled. Place everything loose inside the cart.

BLUE Cart Recycling Guide:

All of the following will be collected together inside the **BLUE** cart.

*** Please do not put garbage or non-recyclables in your recycling cart.**

Paper



- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Office paper
- Cardboard
- Paperboard (shoeboxes, etc.)
- Mail

Glass Bottles & Jars



- Clear and colored glass. Leave labels on, discard tops

Plastics



- Narrow-neck bottles and jugs only



Metal Cans



- Aluminum, steel and tin cans, including pet food, soup, evaporated milk, fruit
